JUNIORBOAT - CLINKER BUILD

As most people know, the Nordic clinker boat tradition is included on UNESCO's list of the intangible cultural heritage of humanity. But what does that mean? UNESCO's definition: (here clipped from TS's website) "... the practices, ideas, expressions, knowledge, skills [...] that societies, groups, and, in some cases, individuals recognize as part of their cultural heritage...". NEW KEEL BOLTS - DAY 0

When I lifted J397 out of its winter storage, I found that the nut on the front bracket for the center lift was "loose". In a wooden boat, there are two fittings, and not just one bolt that you lift in. "Loose" meant in fact that the uppermost part of the thread had simply been corroded away.

I've been given different advice: It ranges from knocking bolts down, one at a time (if you can, my addition), then putting a new one in and tightening. So the boat doesn't come apart. To remove the keel completely and have the bolts drilled out at the workshop. While temporarily attaching the dead wood to the rest of the boat using screws.

While the summer still offers the possibility of sailing, I go and gather myself to decide on a strategy. Knowing that I may have to change it anyway.

I am therefore interested to hear if anyone has experience changing keel bolts in a junior boat? I will report my efforts here in the newsletter and on facebook. And right now I have reached day o!
